Respect Your Neighbors When Playing Music

Spring is here and everyone wants to enjoy the warmer weather. Please be aware that not everyone enjoys the same type of music. We have two ordinances that deal with this issue and they are the following:

- ✓ The playing of any radio, stereo, computer or musical instrument or device in such a manner or with such volume, particularly between the hours of 9:00 pm and 7:00 am, so as to annoy or disturb the quiet, comfort, or repose of any person in any residence, office, dwelling, business, public place, or any person in the vicinity is prohibited.
- ✓ The use or operation of a loudspeaker or sound amplification device in connection with any radio, tape recorder, stereo, computer, microphone, or other devices in which the emanated sounds are of such a strength, character, intensity, or duration so as to annoy or disturb the quiet, comfort, or repose of any person in any residence, office, dwelling, business, public place, or any person in the vicinity is prohibited.

Please try to enjoy your music and respect your neighbors at the same time so everyone can enjoy time in the outdoors.

- ✓ All aerosol products (spray paint, hair spray, etc.)
- ✓ Motor oil, antifreeze, gas, brake fluid, etc.
- ✓ Asbestos containing products
- ✓ Batteries: Lithium, NI-CAD, Metal Hydride Batteries (no alkaline)
- ✓ Drain cleaners, household cleaners, metal polishes
- ✓ Driveway sealers, deck sealers and cleaners, paint removers
- ✓ Pool chemicals
- ✓ Fertilizer, herbicide, pesticide, insecticide
- ✓ Compact fluorescent lamps and tubes
- ✓ Solvents: Mineral spirits, kerosene, thinners, sealers
- ✓ Mercury (thermometers, thermostats)
- ✓ Oil-based paints, stains, varnishes, sealers
- ✓ Personal care products: cosmetics, shampoos, nail polish, etc.
- ✓ Medications: over-the-counter and prescription (people and pet)
