IV Business – discussion/approvals/resolutions

a) Round Lake Management Commission Request for Increased Contribution

Mr. Ken Schnur made a presentation asking for the Communities to increase the amount of money they pledged from \$500.00 to \$1500.00

Mr. Doug Buhl made a presentation that indicated the uses the additional funding would enable the Commission to do.

b) Park Projects Update

Village engineer Bob Devery presented updates on both the new Lakefront Park and the Civic Center Park.

c) East End Lift Station Property

A resident with property adjacent to the East End Lift Station has requested he be able to lease a portion of the lift station property.

The Committee voted to retain possession of the lot but would allow a 5 year lease.

- d) Round Lake Ecosystem Restoration Project  
Public Works Director Keith Neitzke advised the Committee that Lake County Grading will be awarded the contract. Discussion on meeting scheduled for advising residents of the project.
- e) Clarke Mosquito Report for June  
Director Neitzke presented information from Clarke regarding the mosquito population and abatement procedures.
- f) North & South Channel Drive Access Points  
Administrator Kilbane advised the Committee of a residents request to purchase the easement adjacent to his property. The Committee agreed to retain the property but would be agreeable to a lease agreement.
- g) Quite Zone Corridor (discussion)  
Bob Devery stated 11 communities will be part of the Quite Zone including Round Lake Beach. The Committee discussed the safety and benefits of this program.

Other:

Trustee Miosi advised the Committee of children swimming in the water by the boat ramp. Security and CenCom not handling the situation immediately. Discussion on installing "NO SWIMMING" signs.

V Public Participation

Mr. Raed Sulieman, 31 N. Channel concerned with kids swimming off his pier.

Mr. Ted Lohman 14 E Wildwood, safety concerns in regard to children in the roadway near new park and the reconstruction and future road construction.

Ms. Susan Ruhl 7 Wildwood, agreed with his safety concern.

Engineer Bob Devery stated the additional improvements scheduled will rectify this possible situation.

Mr. Tom Ruhl, 7 Wildwood stated due to the dredging 2 feet of the channel has been lost at his property. He was also promised by the dredging Contractor and former Director Erb that if he allowed the contractor to use his driveway that his driveway would be paved upon completion and the contractor would clean his fence from all of the "slop". These have not been taken care of by the Contractor. Also he thought "fishing rocks" were to be installed along the channel. Engineer Devery state that was an option but was not accepted in the plans. Mr. Ruhl is also concerned with fishermen on the banks obstruction boat traffic.

Mr. Raed Sulieman, 31 N. Channel is concerned with his privacy due to the new park.
