2. Participation during the public hearing:

- Individuals who do not wish to speak during the public hearing may simply check the part of the form that indicates whether they support or are opposed to the application. The individual's name and their position on the application will be read aloud into the record at the hearing. Any written comments submitted by an individual in conjunction with their position will also be read into the record, subject to compliance with the Village's public comment and public hearing rules and procedures.
- Individuals who sign up to speak in this manner will receive an email from Village staff after the sign-up time ends with information about how to join the meeting.
- Individuals who fail to complete the speaker sign-up form by the deadline may participate in the hearing by following the instructions provided on the meeting agenda.
