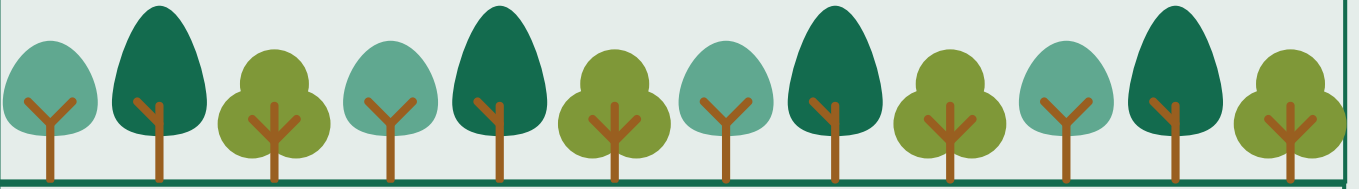


ARBOR DAY 2021

Arbor Day started in 1872 by J. Sterling Morton, a Nebraska newspaper editor. On that first Arbor Day, more than 1 million trees were planted in Nebraska
